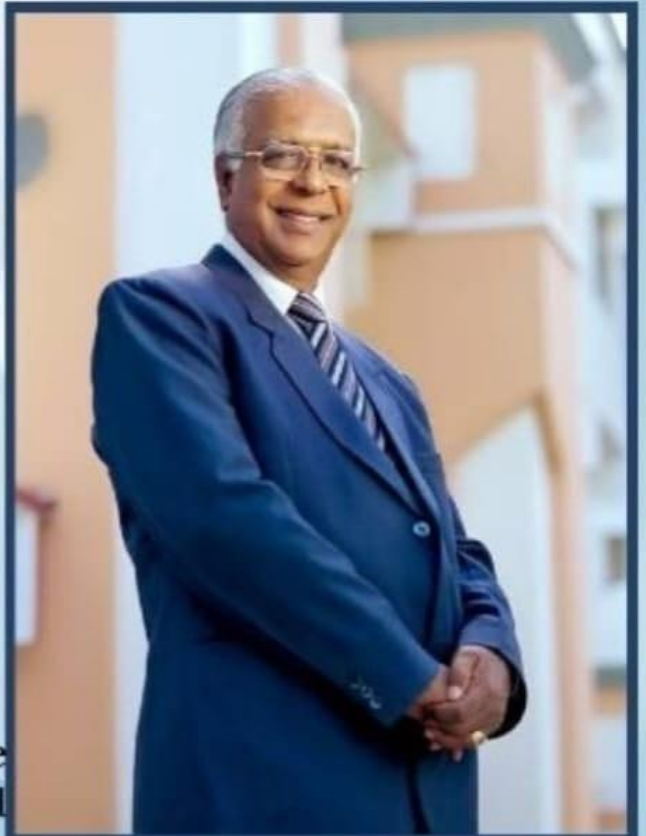

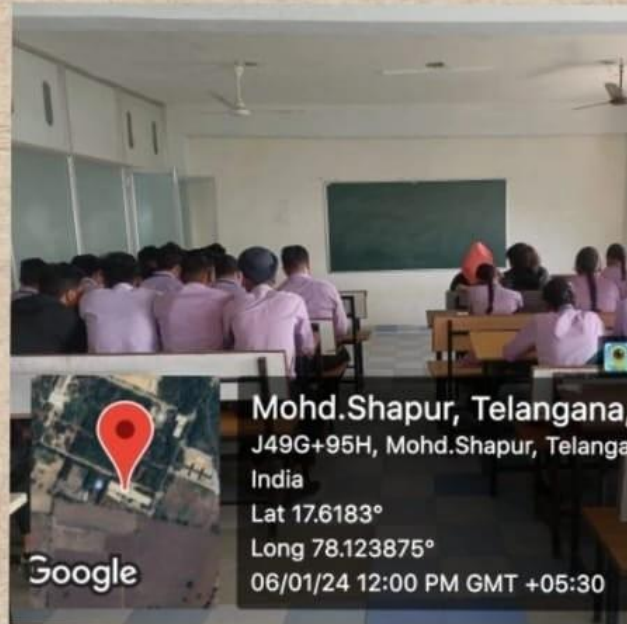

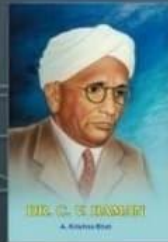

GREAT INDIAN ENGINEERS

Vinod Dham

Indian-American engineer and entrepreneur

He invented the Pentium microprocessor chip, a word widely used in the field of computers. Additionally, Vinod is a co-inventor of the SD card, a type of flash memory that is extensively used in digital cameras and USB devices. He later created the AMD K6, also referred to as the "Pentium Killer." Additionally, he was a pioneering co-inventor of Intel's Flash Memory Technology (ETOX).

He has received a promotion to Vice President of Intel Co.'s Microprocessor Group. He is also an entrepreneur and a venture capitalist. He serves on the advisory boards of numerous corporations as well as start-ups that receive funding from his India-focused Indo-US Venture Partners.



Vinod Dham is the Co-Founder & President at AlphaICs also the founder at IndoUS Venture Partners. He is a mentor, advisor and sits on the boards of companies, including startups funded through his India-based fund Indo-US Venture Partners, where he is the founding managing director.

SATHISH DHAWAN

Indian mathematician and aerospace engineer

If there ever raises a question as to who is the father of experimental fluid dynamics research in India, then there is only one indisputable name worthy of that honour and that man is Satish Dhawan. He was a mathematician and an aerospace engineer. He began his studies in India before relocating to the United States for his higher studies. He was a major player in the study of boundary layers and turbulence, and he oversaw the successful and creative growth of the Indian Space Programme. He was the Indian Space Research Centre's third chairman after two previous replacements (ISRO).

The birth anniversary of Swami Vivekananda also called Swami Vivekananda Jayanti is celebrated every year on 12 January. He was born on 12 January 1863. The government had decided to observe it as Rashtriya Yuva Diwas because the philosophy of Swamiji and the ideals for which he lived and worked could be a great source of inspiration for the Indian Youth. He had given a speech at the Parliament of the World's Religions in Chicago and glorified India's name.

15 January - Pongal

One of the most popular festivals in India is Pongal and is celebrated widely by the Tamil community across the globe. As per the Tamil solar calendar, Pongal is celebrated in Tai month. It is a four-day event that is dedicated to the Sun God. It is a four-day festival. Therefore, it will be celebrated from 15 January to 18 January 2024.

Indian Army Day:

Every year 15 January is observed as Indian Army Day because on this day in 1949 field Marshal Kodandera M Cariappa took over as the first Commander-in-Chief of the Indian Army from General Sir Francis Butcher, the last British Commander-in-Chief.

24 January- National Girl Child Day

He also earned the title of 'Punjab Kesari' or 'the Lion of Punjab'. He initiated the foundation of the Punjab National Bank. He died on 17 November 1928
